Vice President Don Goulet had nothing to report.

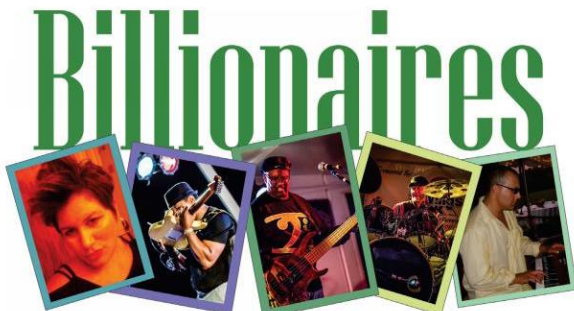
