Minutes: General Membership Meeting of May 2, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 6:08pm by President Bill Cooper and refreshments were enjoyed right away, while they were hot.

No corrections were noted to the April meeting minutes; a motion was made by Tim Wright, seconded by Don Goulet, and the minutes were approved by the membership. Treasurer Ann Goehner reported balances as of March 31st as Checking: \$ and Investment: \$ There were no new members or guests in attendance tonight.

Under Public Relations, Don Goulet made the motion (as presented in the May newsletter) to help fund projects that are consistent with our organization's purpose and provide some public relations for the UDT, by allowing \$20,000 total be made available through the end of 2017, with the intention of \$5,000 maximum allowed for each event. The motion was seconded by Vickie Holley and was passed unanimously. Diane Knowlton pointed out funding suggestions in the program she saved from a recent Symphoria event; amounts vary but patrons are listed in all their programs & on their website. Ann reminded Bill of the opportunity to sponsor the stage at Cold Springs Harbor Marina; Diane will call them and find out the information for Bill.

In Membership, the Meet Out/Eat Out dates for May are Thursday the 11th at Delphia's in Chittenango and Fire Keepers in Nedrow on Tuesday the 23rd; a visit to Barado's on the Water in Brewerton will be on Tuesday, June 27th. There's also the annual Strawberry Social on Monday, June 19th, at the Onondaga Yacht Club from 6pm-9pm, tickets \$7; with entertainment by Ann Barnes. Under Sunshine, a card was sent to Yvonne Russell to cheer her while dealing with significant neck pain & procedures.

Programs Director Josie Losurdo was absent. A reminder was made that the Arts & Crafts BBQ will be held on Friday, July 28th. We have been using Phil D'Alesandro's van to transport supplies and Bill may end up purchasing it for his own (& UDT's) use.

Vice President Don Goulet announced that he and Len Kolakowski have had scheduling problems with meeting up with Amaus Health Services administrators, but may be able to on Wednesday this week. Their 2016 Award for Excellence presentation will happen shortly.

There was no Unfinished Business or New Business. In Membership Announcements, Bill offered an update on his recent health issues.
