Metered Parking Increases in Syracuse

\$2 per hour to park at meters in Downtown Syracuse

New parking meter rates took effect throughout the City of Syracuse, including meters in Downtown Syracuse.

The cost to park at metered spaces is now \$.05 per minute, \$.10 for three minutes, \$.25 for seven minutes, \$1.00 for 30 minutes and \$2 per hour. The parking fee increase was approved by Syracuse Common Council as part of the 2020 fiscal year city budget and will ultimately save neighbors from other initially proposed increases.

The Downtown Committee of Syracuse regularly updates a parking brochure, providing a list of all available lots and garages.


